

# Please Read – Disclaimer & Advice



## Sorry, I can NOT paint....

- Children under 2 years of age, without exception. Some manufacturer's guidelines do not allow me to paint children under 3 years of age and therefore only certain products will be chosen for their faces.
- Resistant children – If your child is crying and scared, it is not nice for me or the child.
- Children who are not accompanied by a parent/carer.
- Dirty or sticky faces! Please clean your face before your turn.
- For safety reasons we cannot paint anyone who is suffering from a cold, eye infections, or an infection of the skin including cold sores or chicken pox, or if a person has head lice. Please do not que if you or your child falls into any of these categories.
- Any persons or children who suffer from skin conditions affecting their face including eczema – this is to prevent further irritation.
- Please don't ask for yourself, or your child to be painted if you have sensitive skin or allergies to face paint. **Any face painting is done at own risk and I will not be held responsible for any adverse reactions that may occur.**

My face paints are easily removed with a lather of mild soap and warm water worked gently into the skin – avoid strong rubbing. It is possible for some colours to stain and take a day or two to wash out all the pigment from the skin. It is not advised to leave paints on longer than 4 hours.

I only use professional cosmetic grade paints & glitters for use on skin which comply with EU regulations. Each individual's skin varies in sensitivity and there is always a risk of skin irritation. A patch test can be requested before you line up if you are unsure. I will not be held liable for any reactions to my products.
